The GEPF Roadshow to visit Kokstad.

Pretoria - The Government Employees Pension Fund (GEPF), through its national outreach campaign, will visit Kokstad in the KwaZulu Natal Province. The event will be held on Saturday, 08 October 2016 at Oval Sports Ground, Kokstad Central.

The main purpose for this initiative is to interact with the GEPF's active members, pensioners and beneficiaries in order to inform and educate them about the Fund's services, processes and benefits, such as funeral and unclaimed benefits. Members will have their queries and questions attended to on site and they will also to be able to update their personal information.

The GEPF has over 4 550 active GEPF members with more than 3 800 pensioners and beneficiaries in Kokstad and the surrounding areas. It is these members we hope to attract to the event and engage on pension related issues affecting them.

Through this outreach campaign, the GEPF intends to address issues such as financial brokers who are masquerading as GEPF employees and offering members GEPF services and products, while at the same time advising them to resign instead of retiring by promising too good to be true financial returns.

GEPF members are promised inflated and incorrect financial returns. Sadly, those who fall to this trick only realise very late that it was not true. The GEPF does not encourage members to resign because we want them to grow their benefits until retirement age and thus guarantee them life-long monthly payments as well as medical care for those who belong to medical schemes.

Members will also be encouraged not to resign when they approach the retirement age as this puts them at a disadvantage and they tend to lose out on other benefits that are enjoyed by retired pensioners.
